Class syllabus: The object of the subject is to emphasize the irreplaceable role of literary translation in intercultural communication, as well as in cultivating the domestic cultural tradition and its literary language. The theoretical part of the syllabus defines the specifics of literary translation in relation to pragmatic translation, while at the same time it defines the basic phases and aspects of the process of literary translation.
