In addition to theoretical knowledge, the student will also gain skills in the use of statistical methods in selected statistical software.

Statistical induction for numerical data. Introduction to linear regression. Basics of two-dimensional sorting (contingency table, graph) and analysis of the dependence of two categorical variables.
