Class syllabus:

Firstly, we introduce a range of theoretical approaches to study these cultural phenomena, exploring the intersection between oral tradition and Web 2.0, folklore texts and mass media, and global and local cultural flows. Secondly, building on knowledge of these conceptual approaches, we will examine several examples of contemporary folkloric forms: hoaxes, fake news, conspiracy theories, rumours, contemporary legends, jokes, anecdotes, and memes.

Requirements for the students will comprise final practical essay and possible discussion during its presentation.
