Class syllabus: Recent migration crisis in Europe requires, in addition to the responses of politicians and security experts also a theological position and a response of churches. The experience of migration influenced the formation of the biblical Israel and this experience found reflection also in the self-perception of the church standing behind the New Testament text. This seminar explores relevant NT texts that can serve as a basis for formulation of theological positions to the migration phenomena and to migrants. 1 week: Introduction to the topic and the methodology of the seminar, distribution of assignments. 2 week: Introduction to the topic of the seminar: Christianity and migration. 3 – 12 week: presentation of assignments, discussion.
