The course will provide students with the current knowledge in the field of traditional and new digital media and their impact on the mental health of their users in different age groups. The course focuses on addictions and negative phenomena related to social networks, video game addiction, the impact of the media on obesity, eating disorders, body image, media and the risk of different types of addiction - alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, celebrities, antisocial internet behavior, violence in the media. After the successful completion of the course, students will understand the connection of theoretical knowledge in the field of media, regarding cultural, historical, social, or physical conditions, the risks of addictive behavior, which in many cases leads to addictions and manifestations of antisocial behavior. Emphasis is on the evolving individual as the instigator and co-creator of his own development. The course meets the attributes that consider the uniqueness of development and represents a bridge from general knowledge to more specific, providing better starting point for teaching applied psychological disciplines, formulation of complex research projects and psychological practice. The course also includes the topic of media literacy and its preventive effects and knowledge of neuroscience regarding the health risks of media.
