Learning outcomes: After completing it, the student has comprehensive knowledge of canon law, is able to navigate its norms and their practical application. He is familiar with the historical and theoretical background of the law of the Catholic Church, at the same time he is capable of solving practical church law problems and cases that occur in practice.	
Class syllabus: 1. History of canon law; 2. Theory (general norms) of canon law; 3. People of God - the rights and obligations of all believers, including the rights and obligations of clerics; 4. Hierarchical organization of the Church: Roman High Priest, Cardinals, Roman Curia, ecclesiastical provinces 5. Hierarchical organization of the Church at the diocesan and parish level; 6. Matrimonial canon law - definition of marriage, goals of marriage, marital consent and marital obstacles; 7. Matrimonial canon law - form of marriage celebration, convalidation and dissolution of marriage; 8. General (static part) of canonical procedural law; 9. Dynamic part of the canonical process - dispute process; 10. Matrimonial processes in canon law; 11. Criminal canon law (material); 12. Criminal and administrative canonical process (including beatification and canonization process); 13. Property rights of the Catholic Church; 14. Code of Canons of the Eastern Churches.
