Church in the Frankish Empire, consolidation of the papacy in Western Europe, Donatio Constantini, development of the Western Church under Charlemagne, the disintegration of the Carolignian dynasty. 2. Beginning of Feudalism - European conditions and theological problems in the 9th and 10th centuries. Reform in Cluny. 3. Church under Otto I. the Great, schism of 1054, the relationship between the German emperors and the papacy, battles on the investiture, Pope Gregory VII., Concordat of Worms (1122), Innocent III. - medieval peak of papacy ; the importance and causes of the crusades. 4. Learning outcomes: The student has general knowledge of the historical background and processes in regard to the origin of the early Christian movement, its historical background and development. Students are able to gain and use critical thinking by an analysis and evaluation of the basic knowledge about the process previous to the forming and evaluation of the early Christian churches, particularly: The knowledge of the political, cultural, and religious situation of the ancient world, from the period of destruction of the Babylonian Empire to the period of the dominance of the Roman Empire, its influence on the Second Temple Judaism, the part of which was an early Christian movement, as well as the other significant political, cultural, and religious phenomena of the ancient Graeco-Roman world. Passing this propaedeutic course is a precondition to passing other courses of the New Testament – Exegesis of the New Testament and Theology of the New Testament.
