In the examination, the student may use all available sources of legal information, in particular uncommented legislation, commentaries, case law, legal literature and legal information systems. Grading scale: A/1 = 91-100%; B/1.5 =81-90%; C/2 = 73-80%; D/2.5 = 66-72%; E: 60-65%, Fx: 0-59%. Scale of assessment (preliminary/final): 100/0	
<b>Learning outcomes:</b> A) Knowledge: After completing the course, students will have broad knowledge of individual means of evidence and their possible use in criminal proceedings, administrative proceedings, and civil proceedings. Students will have cross-sectional knowledge of individual areas and will be able to define the differences in evidence in individual branches of law. Students will know the theoretical basis of individual means of evidence and will be able to define the results that can be obtained and expected from these means of evidence. B) Skills: Students are able to question and argue the persuasiveness and validity of evidence in individual proceedings. In particular, they are able to propose the use of individual means of evidence in court proceedings, check the legality of this evidence, its relevance to the case, and its connection to other evidence. The student is able to critically evaluate the results of evidence, argue for their correctness or incorrectness, and appropriately use the tools of the relevant procedural rules to achieve the desired results of the proceedings. C) Responsibility and independence: The student is particularly qualified to create a comprehensive procedural strategy for evidence. Students are able to choose the most appropriate means of evidence from a range of options and decide for themselves on their relevance to criminal, administrative, or civil proceedings. Students master the tactics of evidence and the possibilities of intervening in it from the perspective of individual legal professions, as well as how to argue in court proceedings to support their claims.	

Teaching that also takes into account the requirements of practical application in the areas of the judiciary, public prosecution, and legal professions, which are supervised by the Ministry of Justice of the Slovak Republic.

**Class syllabus:**

1. Concept and object of the law of evidence. Basic concepts of the law of evidence, terminological differences from the point of view of several legal disciplines. Comparison of the principles relating to evidence in selected proceedings before public authorities, with an emphasis on the issues of the distribution of the burden of proof and the burden of proof between the procedural subjects and the consequences of their failure to do so.
